The speakers at the 2010 Bible School are:

**Professor Andy McIntosh** and  
**Rev. John Mark Teeuwen**



**Professor Andy McIntosh**, holds a chair in Thermodynamics in the School of Process, Environmental and Materials Engineering at the University of Leeds, where he lectures and researches in the field of Aerodynamics, Combustion and Explosions. In recent years he has begun research in the area of biomimetics (studying nature with a view to copying mechanisms to engineering advantage). In particular he has an ongoing research project where the minute combustion chamber of the bombardier beetle has been studied. He is a trained mathematician and has worked in aerodynamics at Cranfield University and the Royal Aircraft

Establishment (Bedford) before coming to Leeds where he gained a DSc in 1998 and a personal chair in 2000. Andy became a believer in 1969 when prompted by a Christian Youth group leader to recognise that he needed to Admit his guilt, Believe that Christ died for him and Commit his life to Christ. This he did as the Lord spoke to him through that vital advice, before going up to University in 1970, where he quickly understood from the kind instruction of a godly CU leader that if the Bible is true, then it must be true from the beginning. His leanings to science made him realise that he must be clear on the issue of Creation / Evolution. As well as writing many research papers, he has written numerous articles on Creation vs Evolution. His book 'Genesis for Today' - showing the relevance of the Creation/ Evolution debate to today's society' published by Day One is now in its 3rd edition and he has contributed chapters to other books - just recently the latest book 'Should Christians embrace evolution?' published by IVP. For 10 years up to 2001 Andy led an inner city church in the Leeds area before
